

# 5月14日「産経新聞(朝刊)」1面にワクチンバスが掲載されました。

【記事内容】コロナ禍で運行本数が減ったバスを、移動式のワクチン接種会場として活用する動きが始まっている。バス会社のアイビーエス（東京都港区）は、観光バスなどを改造して接種・経過観察スペースを設置。過疎地域などでの利用を想定する。担当者は「5月は繁忙期だが、今はほぼ稼働ゼロ。接種に役立ててもらい、早く安心して旅行できるようになれば」と話す。
